# Indoors




Fix leaky faucets and toilets


Appliances and fixtures may be purchased at most hardware, appliance and home improvement stores.



Install water-wise toilets and clothes and dish washers



Install flow restrictors on faucets and take shorter showers.



Install high efficiency toilets and water-saving clothes and dish washers.



Run only full loads in dish and clothes washers.

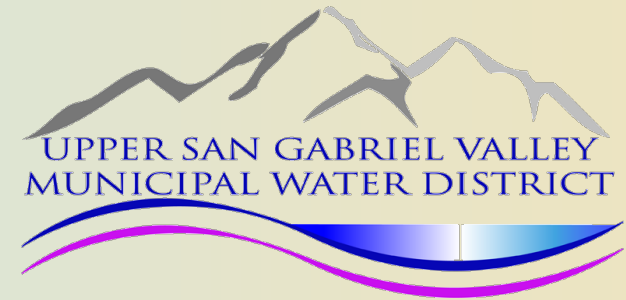
